# 1. COCL updates

#### Office hours:

- To be established with Mandi.
- It will be a space for COAB members to work and have computer access.

#### Admin hired:

- Mandi Hood, starts Monday.
- Kathleen will send a letter to the COAB introducing and welcoming her.

### Community survey:

Amy will send final survey out to COAB.

### COAB member changes:

• Cory Murphy resigned; Vanessa Gonzalez removed due to unexcused absences.

A record of COAB member responsibilities, terms is to be created – make the processes clearer.

- When somebody is an alternate, they move up, sign that piece of paper.
- Setting ground rules.

### 2. Budget Proposal

Sharon walked everyone through the proposal:

- It would incorporate tabling for community events (Sharon's note).
- Perhaps there is a need to rethink the budget: instead have it based on what COAB needs to do their work, not how to carve up \$30K.
- Sharon to go to subcommittee chairs with a budget template to solicit feedback.
- For retreat \$4-5000, should take 2-3 months to plan.

### 3. The Community Engagement and Outreach Plan (CEO Plan)

A handout that Jimi referenced at last night's COAB meeting was briefly discussed.

It could help with a timeline issue Bud raised

Members wanted to request the Portland Police Association (PPA) and the Albina Ministerial Alliance (AMA) side agreements.

## 4. Bylaw updates

This would incorporate the Data Systems, Use of Force and Compliance Subcommittee's (DSUFCS) request that the Executive Committee consider adding Accountability as a charge to DSUFCS or if it should be its own subcommittee.

• It would also address new members of subcommittees (including community members) and new subcommittees, per Sharon's note below.

## **Sub-Committee Votes:**

The COAB shall appoint sub-committees to address specific aspects of the COAB's work as determined by the COAB. The creation of new subcommittees or changes to existing subcommittees, including a description and scope, may be proposed to the Executive Committee by the COCL or by a majority vote of the voting COAB members of an existing subcommittee. The Executive Committee shall vote to forward a recommendation to the full COAB for a vote of approval.

Yes: Bud Feuless, Philip Wolfe, Sharon Maxwell, Avel Gordly

Motion passes unanimously, 4-0

The entire membership of a subcommittee may vote on procedural issues related to the subcommittee's work, including selection of a chair and vice-chair. Recommendations to the Executive Committee and/or full COAB may only be made by a majority vote of the voting COAB members of a subcommittee.

VOTE:

Bud moved, Sharon seconded Yes: Bud Feuless, Philip Wolfe, Sharon Maxwell, Avel Gordly Motion passes unanimously, 4-0

Sub-committees may include non-voting COAB members previously designated as alternates, and members of public. A member of the public who wishes to serve on a subcommittee may be nominated by a voting COAB member after attending two subcommittee meetings. A majority vote of the voting COAB members of the subcommittee is required to confirm the membership of a member of the public.

VOTE:

Bud moved, Philip seconded Yes: Bud Feuless, Philip Wolfe, Sharon Maxwell, Avel Gordly Motion passes unanimously, 4-0

Each sub-committee must select a Chair. The Chair will be responsible for setting the agenda and leading subcommittee meetings. The Chair will also speak for the sub-committee at any meetings, including status reporting at regular meetings of the COAB. In order to maintain the balance and integrity of COAB's carefully selected representation, the Chair must be a voting member of the COAB. A vice-Chair, also a voting member of COAB, may also be selected to act as a stand-in for the Chair in the case of their unavailability.

Bud moved; Sharon seconded Yes: Bud Feuless, Philip Wolfe, Sharon Maxwell, Avel Gordly Motion passes unanimously, 4-0

COAB members may serve on no more than two subcommittees (including the Executive Committee), and may only chair or vice-chair one subcommittee at any time.

Sharon moved; Bud seconded Yes: Bud Feuless, Philip Wolfe, Sharon Maxwell, Avel Gordly Motion passes unanimously, 4-0

Kathleen has a few additional ideas; will bring to a future Executive Committee meeting.
